Currently we are offering a Summer Writing Club. Registration begins **July 1st** and the club will run on Wednesdays for 6 weeks, with the first virtual meet up starting on **Wednesday**, **July 14th**.

This Writing Club offers participants the chance to focus on writing projects by providing accountability, a writing community, and techniques for idea generation. Using the <u>Pomodoro Technique</u>, we will write during 15-minute quiet periods with 5-minute breaks (for short discussions) in between.
