Adult Summer Reading Club

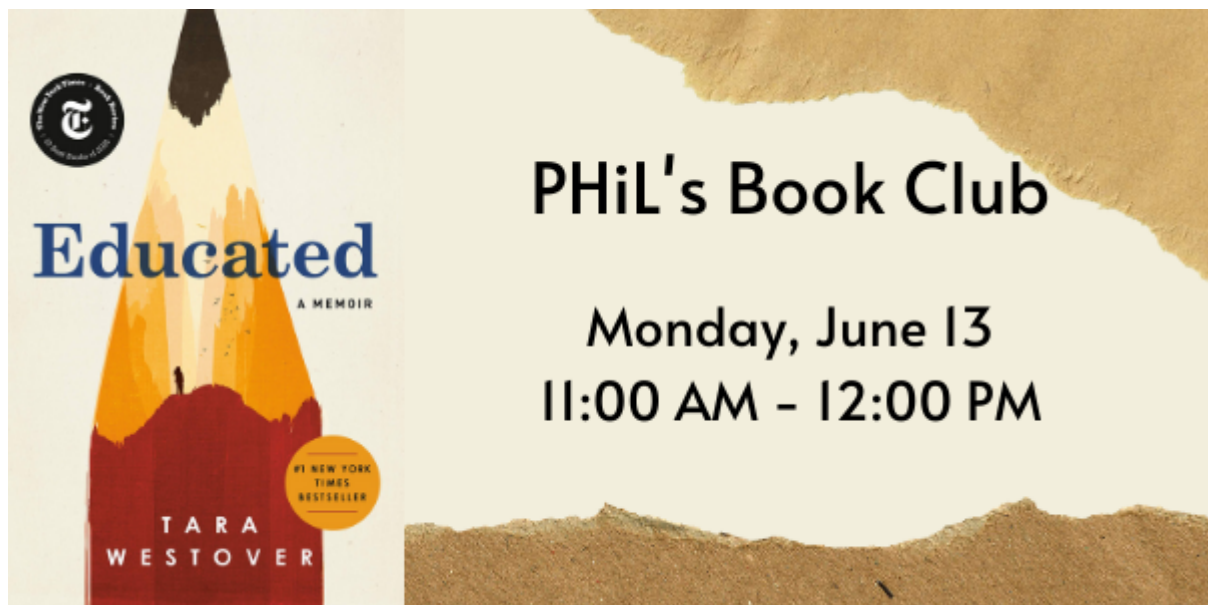
Sign up starts June 4th

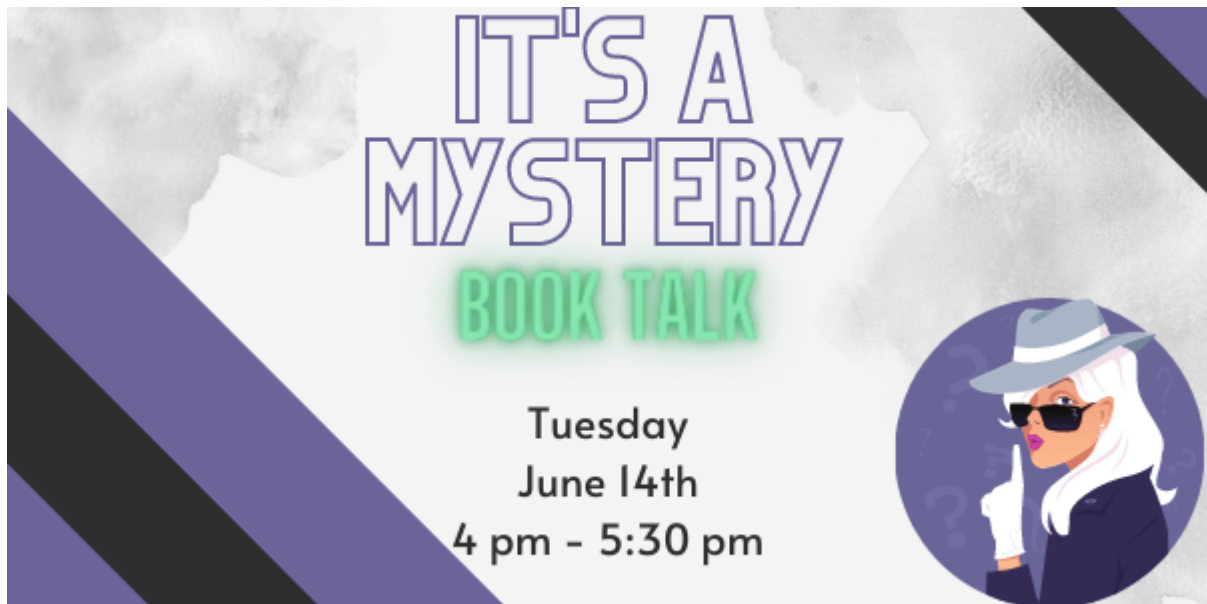
