



Join the **Palm Harbor Community Chorus** here at the library for their 2022 Christmas Concert. All ages are welcome! Please register for the event <u>here</u>.



Book Clubs




Do you love **cozy mysteries**? Join our monthly group to discuss which cozy you're currently reading and learn about new ones!






Join us for all things anime! This club meets once a month, so if you miss this month, try to catch them next month!




Great Explorations: Super Bodies


