Virtual Author Talks

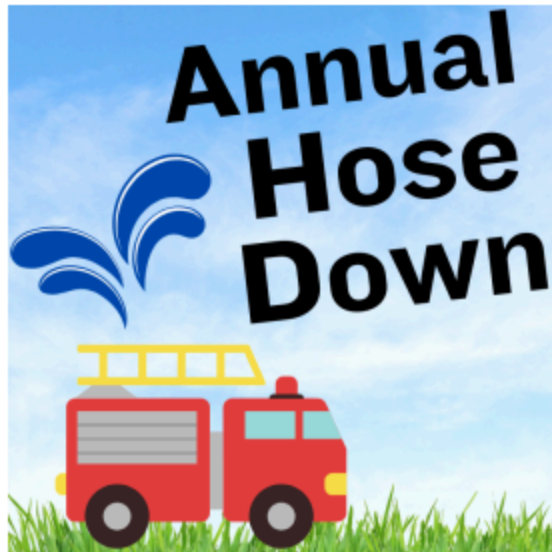
