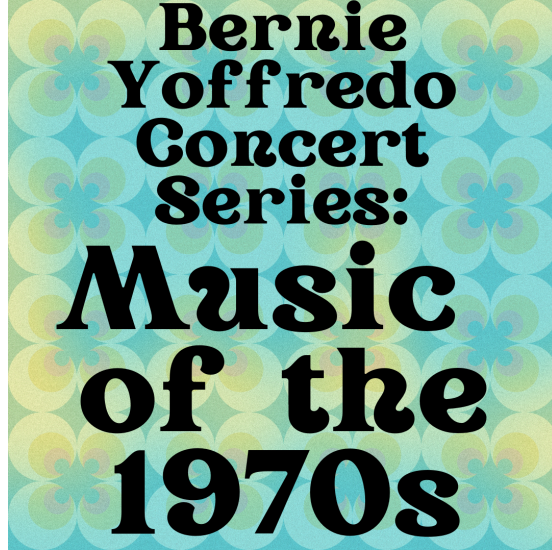


**America250: Palm Harbor Museum Presents The

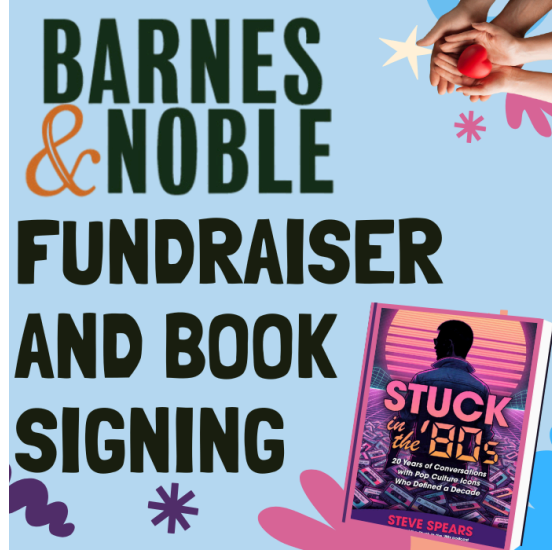

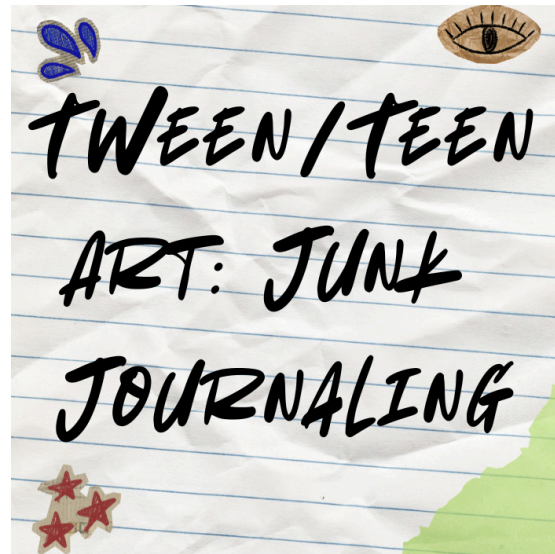
